

1 Insert your micro SIM card and media card



1. Open the door on the left side of your smartphone.
2. Insert the micro SIM card.
3. Insert a media card if you have one.
4. Close the door.

The battery is already inserted. It cannot be removed.

2 Set up your smartphone

1. Press and hold the **Power on/off** key to turn on your smartphone.
2. Follow the instructions on the screen.


Sign in using your BlackBerry ID or create a BlackBerry ID if you don't have one. BlackBerry ID helps sync information (for example, contacts) between your smartphone and computer. It also manages your apps and services, to help you transfer information when you switch smartphones.

After the initial setup, tap **Setup** on the home screen to set up your email, social networking accounts, and BBM.

3 Transfer information to your smartphone




Pinpoint and adjust exact moments of your picture to create the perfect shot. Use BlackBerry Story Maker to merge these moments and create a movie.

1 BlackBerry Hub



From any app, stay close to what's important with one fast and fluid gesture. Just a swipe to the right lets you peek at the BlackBerry Hub, allowing you to flow in and out of your messages and conversations.



Swipe to the left and you have all your apps at your fingertips.

2 Active Frames

When you're ready to leave an app, you can minimize the app, or close it.

1. To minimize an app, just swipe up from the bottom of the screen. The app is minimized and appears as one of your Active Frames.
2. If you want to close the app completely, tap **X**.



3 Wake up your smartphone

Swipe up from the bottom of the screen and release your finger half-way up.

To put your smartphone to sleep, press the **Lock screen** key.

For extra security, you can set a password that you enter when you wake up your smartphone. On the home screen, swipe down from the top of the screen and tap **Settings > Security and Privacy > Device Password**.



4 Show menus or more actions

In an app, at the bottom of the screen, tap the **≡** or **⋮** icon. Or, touch and hold an item on the screen.



5 Check notifications and messages

On the home screen or in an app, slide your finger up from the bottom of the screen and pause. Your notifications appear on the left.

To peek into the BlackBerry Hub to check messages, slide your finger to the right.

To stay in your app, slide your finger to the bottom of the screen.



6 Change settings

On the home screen, or in some apps, swipe down from the top of the screen.

Tap **Settings**.



7 Find information with Search

You can search your smartphone for files, messages, contacts, settings, help, and more from one location. You can even extend your search to include Internet sources. Want to learn more about BlackBerry ID or the Time Shift mode? Search can help you.

1. On the home screen, just type your search term.
2. Tap **🔍** to focus your search to a particular area.
